




- It is not formally established program, but in practice we are proceeding as follows:

1. From April 7 to April 28, 2017 (JST): for applicants wishing to enroll in September 2017

*There is a scholarship available for applicants who come to Japan for the first time to pursue a Master's /PhD degree at the School for September 2017 entrance.

2. From October 1 to October 31, 2017 (JST): for applicants wishing to enroll on April1, 2018
